
Open Pharma update: January-June 2019

This year, the Open Pharma team has delivered presentations and led panel discussions on open access publishing, preprints and clinical trial transparency.

Our research investigating the open access options available to the pharma industry was accepted for publication in *BMJ Open* under a CC BY licence.

Open Pharma is working with <u>ORCID</u> to see how ORCID identifiers could be of benefit to the pharma industry. The team is planning to submit an abstract discussing the current uptake of ORCID in the pharma industry to the <u>2020 European Meeting of ISMPP</u>.
